Summary

The Eeyou of MoCreebec have always harvested animals from the land for food, clothing and for passing on knowledge to the next generation. MoCreebec Eeyoud Council supports the efforts of its members in pursuing our Cree way of life out on the land and for strengthen family bonds. This program is subjected to the availability of funds and has interim guidelines for accessing this subsidy program until a well establish program is viable. The Council will advocate for its member and will continue to seek addition resources for this program for future generations.

Objectives

- To provide a subsidy for transportation during the goose harvest season.
- To revitalize and promote cree values, customs and traditions.
- To provide opportunities for our youth to learn and understand their culture and heritage.

Guidelines

- This program is to offer a subsidy to the applicant based upon the information that is provided.
- Forms that are incomplete will be denied!
- All receipts must be submitted (bill of service and payment).
- Funding is year to year and applicants are not guaranteed.
- Applicants will cover 100% of their costs and will apply for the subsidy reimbursement.
- Funding criteria for reimbursement will be define by council.
- All claims must be summited by June 1st administrative purposes.
- Council will review the claims by no later than July for processing.
- Any abuse of the program will find the applicant and family suspended.

Applicant Eligibility

- Must be over 18 years old to apply.
- Must be a signed on member of MoCreebec Eeyoud.
- Must meet the criteria of the funding source. (not all members may not meet the funding source pool)
